## The Sertoma Fantasy Baseball/Softball Camp

Step up to the plate with the confidence you've gained during your week-long experience at Sertoma's Fantasy Baseball/Softball Camp. Take home the major league skills you've learned from experienced coaches and trainers eager to share their expertise. Deaf and hard-of-hearing campers ages 7 through 17 participate in this opportunity to meet new friends and learn new skills playing baseball or softball. Campers using oral methods and cochlear implants are welcome. The camp runs Monday through Friday during the week of August 9th through 13th, 2010, from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. A cap, t-shirt and lunch are provided. The camp is held at Boysen Park, 951 State College Boulevard, Anaheim, California 92806. (Cross streets are State College Boulevard and East Wagner Avenue.)



A special thanks to The Boys and Girls Club of Anaheim who have opened their doors to campers who need extended hours until pick-up no later than 5:30 each day. Transportation from the camp to The Boys and Girls Club located at 311 East Broadway in Anaheim is provided each day free of charge by Sertoma.

During Fantasy Baseball/Softball Camp, campers are trained in the fundamentals of baseball and softball by experienced coaches who are assisted by knowledgeable volunteers from the community and from Sertoma clubs. Trained sign-language interpreters are present at all times throughout each day to assist in communication of instructions. A special day at Angel Stadium of Anaheim is scheduled as part of the camp. The week includes an awards ceremony and two tickets to see an Angels game.

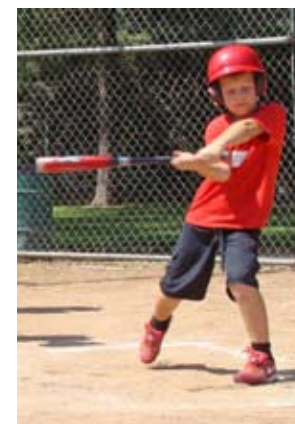
